Old Business

An idea was proposed by the board to begin including a brief member biography in future newsletters. Jeff Craig suggested spotlighting new members; Michelle Paillou thought it would be good to include all members. The membership approved of the biography idea. Patty Craig offered to prepare a biographical form for each member to complete, as he/she wishes. Forms can be drawn randomly for inclusion in the newsletter. Members should include a photo of themselves, spouse, and car.

Patty Craig made the suggestion to provide a sign up list for monthly activity volunteers similar to the birthday cake sign up.
