National Council of Corvette Club Governor's Report

Saint Louis Corvette Club NCCC Governor's Report for October 2010:

- 2011 Convention logoed merchandise is now available through the MWR website. Our Entrant's Choice Car Show is starting the planning process – please get with me if you'd like to help. Our club, Route 66, and Great River will be running the event in Tinley Park. Tinley Park is also sponsoring a street party for townspeople and visitors that night, too. A police escort will be leading the cars from the hotel into downtown Tinley Park that Sunday, June 19. I'll be working on Dave Heinemann, the Co-chair, to come to a club meeting and tell us all about the events going on that week...from June 17 through June 24, 2011. Registration for convention opens Feb. 1, 2011. It will be on the NCCC website, and done online only.
- Elections are coming up, not only for us, but also for the MW region and the National board. The existing MW officers, regional exec. Gary Kelly, regional comp. director Paul Haack, regional treas. Nancy Bailey, regional membership director Sue Puksich, are all running again. Chris Reitz, from Route 66, is stepping up to run for Secretary.
