


















# Ruth's Gringo Chicken Tortilla Soup

2 cups of cooked chicken cubed

1 16 oz jar of Black Bean & Corn Salsa

1 pound of Velveeta cubed

- 1 15 oz can of chicken broth
- 1 15 oz can whole kernel corn (drained)
- 1 can black beans (rinsed and drained)

Stir broth, salsa, corn and black beans together, simmer 10 minutes. Add cubed Velveeta, stir and simmer until melted. Then add your chicken. Serve with tortilla chips and sour cream if desired. We put tortilla chips in the soup bowl as it adds a little crunch to it.

This soup is really good and so easy to make! Just a friendly warning that it does have a little kick to it!
