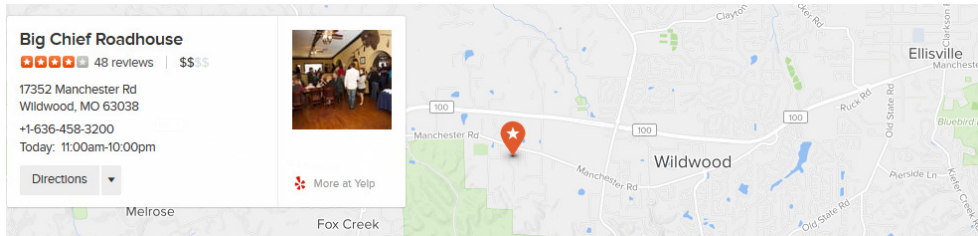

Anyone have a Veteran in their family?

Through my American Legion Post I get information concerning veteran's benefits that I pass along.

There was a recent law enacted which changed who is eligible to have a bronze medallion affixed to a headstone in a private cemetery. It used to be that the person had to have died after October 31, 1990. But due to the recent legislation change, any veteran who died since WWI is now eligible. Here is the website that explains how to obtain a medallion and the paperwork needed: <https://www.cem.va.gov/cem/hmm/eligibility.asp>. The proper form is VA Form 40-1330M. Here is what the form looks like even though it still says the veteran has to have died after October 31, 1990: <https://www.va.gov/vaforms/va/pdf/VA40-1330M.pdf>.

So if you are a veteran this may be of interest to you. And if your parents or grandparents were in the military, they are also now eligible for this medallion.
